

## **An Economic Development Innovation: For The 562 First Nation Tribes.**

Not only does the OmniView™ Total Supervision™ incarceration design help the 562 First Nation Tribes meet and prove compliance with the Prison Rape Elimination Act's (PREA) number one purpose of zero tolerance, it can provide significant economic development opportunities.

The following copyrighted economic development system includes four interdependent parts. This system is tax exempt and requires First Nation Tribal Financial Advisor approval, IRS approval, Special Tax Exempt Bond Counsel approval and is Certificate Of Participation (COP) funded.

The system features a Public Safety Self Sufficient campus, and at the end of twenty years is sold to the First Nation Tribe for \$1.00.

Instead of becoming a financial burden to the community, this program provides significant opportunity for economic development and jobs.

### **What does the 4 part system include?**

The four interdependent parts of the economic development system are two OmniView™ Total Supervision™ detention centers totaling 324 beds, a vocational training center and a Detention Officer training center. This is shown in the diagram below, and explained on the next page.



1. A public safety self-sufficient Tribal, BIA or 638 tax exempt, maximum custody 68 bed space OmniView™ Total Supervision™ PREA number one purpose compliant incarceration facility.
2. A 256 bed space OmniView™ Total Supervision™ PREA number one purpose compliant medium custody incarceration facility, leased juvenile inmate, outside jurisdiction, fee for incarceration services revenue generator. The revenue generated by this fee for incarceration service allows the entire 324 bed facility to be self-sufficient.
3. A non-profit You Visited Me (YVM) vocational training facility. This will provide construction trades, education, training, employment and experience programs helping to eliminate recidivism.
4. A world class, 21<sup>st</sup> century Detention Officer Training Academy to ensure availability of competently trained staff. Having highly trained staff helps to keep operating and liability insurance costs to a minimum.
