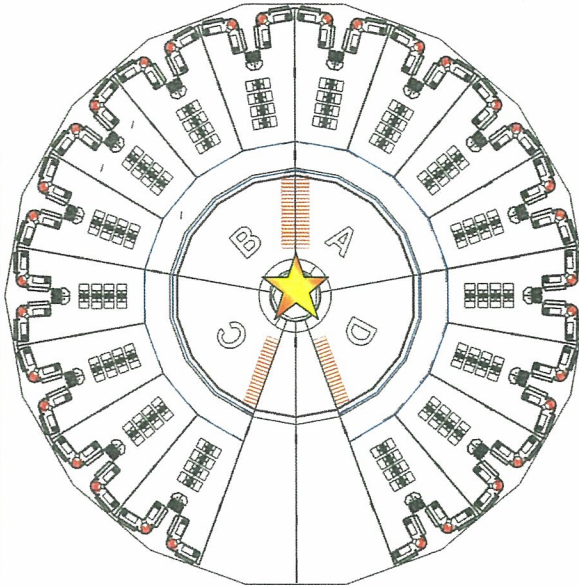

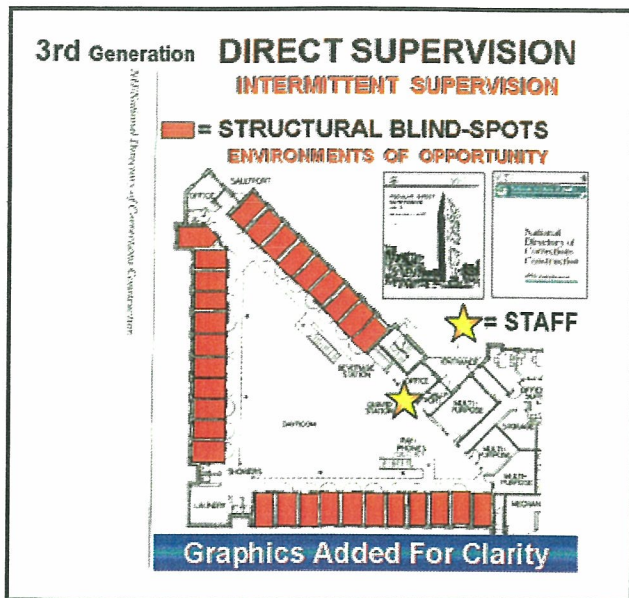

It takes 6.9 seconds for the Control Room Correctional Officer to rotate his command chair 360° to scan all inmates and less than 120 seconds to complete a full 256 inmate count. Each of the six 60° fixed CCTV cameras has a quick & separate play back function which is separate from the total and continual permanent/reviewable archives located in the PPMU Office, and in the Quality Assurance Office.

To develop the OmniView™ TOTAL SUPERVISION™ Fourth Generation model required twenty years of research and the testing of numerous plans and layouts dedicated to finding a truly cost effective, incontrovertibly safer and healthier design. The one of a kind patented incarceration design places a central control room (marked above by the gold star) in the geometric dead center of a circular incarceration facility ensuring all inmate areas are clearly visible through stainless steel aircraft cable reinforced glazed cell fronts. Six, 60° fixed high-definition CCTV cameras record continuous, time and date stamped 100% surveillance which is permanently DVD archived and easily reviewable. Any prohibited act involving an inmate is on permanent DVD file for subsequent investigation and prosecution.

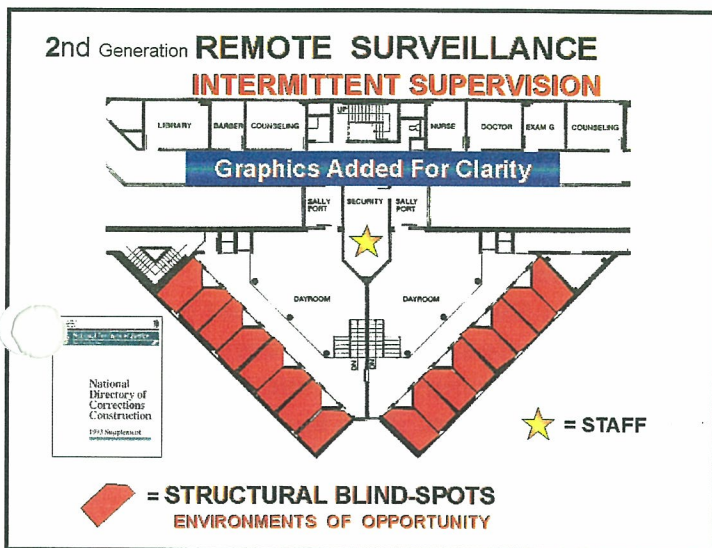
This amazing design allows inmates to be separated into 100% total surveillance units of 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 16, 32, or 48 beds. Frosted Glass is provided for modesty in the shower/wash basin/toilet combination units. The thirty-one year old Direct Supervision (1975) prison design depicted here, places staff in the day room area (marked by the gold star) with some cells facing the control center and others adjacent to the control center.

The Correctional Officer (CO) must walk up to the cell door window and peer in to observe the inmate.

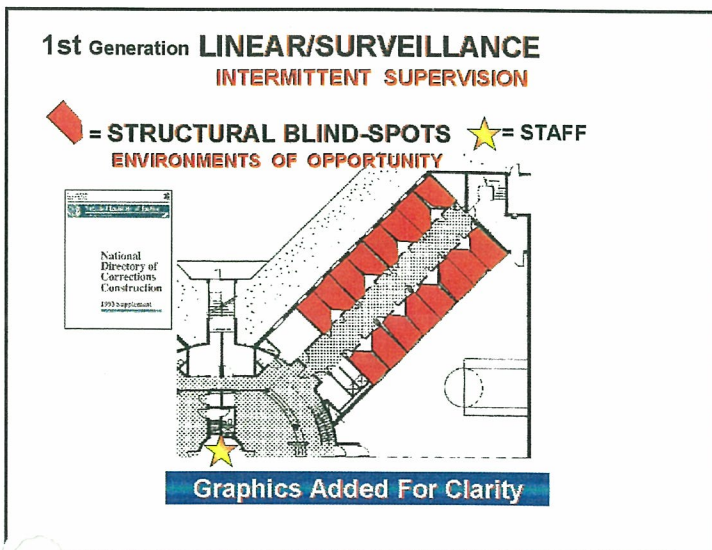
As shown, the Direct Supervision prison design provides only **Intermittent Supervision** of inmates, with **structural blind-spots*** in every single cell.



The Remote Surveillance prison design depicted here, places staff in an enclosed central control area (marked by the gold star) with some cells facing the control center.

The Correctional Officer (CO) must walk up to the cell door window and peer in to observe the inmate.

As shown, the Remote Surveillance prison design provides only **Intermittent Supervision** of inmates, with **structural blind-spots*** in every single cell.



The Linear / Surveillance prison design depicted here, places staff in a central control area (marked by the gold star) with cells located down hallways branching out from the main control area.

The Correctional Officer (CO) must walk up to the cell door window and peer in to observe the inmate.

As shown, the Linear / Surveillance prison design provides only **Intermittent Supervision** of inmates, with **structural blind-spots*** in every single cell.
